Adam Wainwright, STL -	6’8”/230/26 – Great 2 nd half in 2008
Mike Pelfrey, NYM -	6’7”/230/24 – Could steal that 5 th spot from the oft-injured El Duque
Phil Hughes, NYY -	6’5”/220/22 – Should be solid all around in 2008
Scott Olsen, FLA -	6’5”/215/25 – If he screws his head on right, could break out this season
Adam Loewen, BAL -	6’6”/235/25 – Monster size and has K potential
Jason Hirsh, COL -	6’8”/250/25 – If he makes rotation he should have some nice K potential
Daniel Cabrera, BAL -	6’7”/260/27 – Can this guy ever get it together? He’s 27 this season!
Micah Owings, ARI -	6’5”/220/24 – If he can increase his K rate, he’d be a nice sleeper
